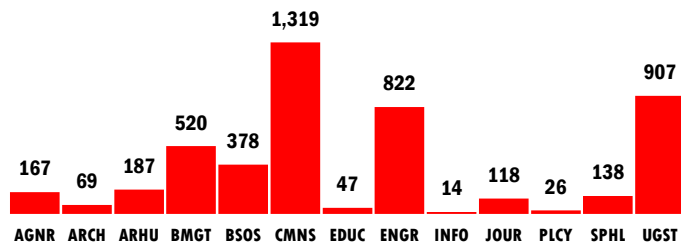
6-YEAR GRADUATION RATE (FALL 2012 COHORT):
