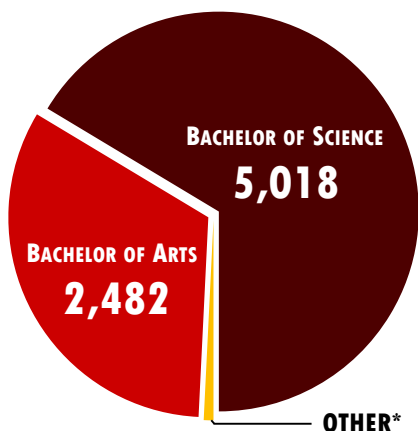


FY 2018 BACHELORS DEGREES AWARDED: **7,559**
